Applying for a job at HealthShare NSW & eHealth NSW

Who is HealthShare NSW?

HealthShare NSW provides support services to the NSW health system. Services include food and patient support, linen services, patient transport, disability services and equipment, procurement and supply logistics, financial (accounts payable, accounts receivable) and employee transactions (payroll, recruitment).

Who is eHealth NSW?

eHealth NSW has been established as a distinct organisation within the NSW Ministry of Health to provide statewide leadership on the shape, delivery and management of ICT-led healthcare.

eHealth NSW is responsible for setting eHealth strategy, policy and standards, and works with Local Health Districts (LHDs) and Health Agencies to implement statewide core systems and ensure compliance with statewide standards.

- Information Services
- Data Centre Reform
- Corporate IT Programs (non-clinical)
- Infrastructure Office

HealthShare NSW and eHealth NSW employ over 8,000 staff with the majority of employees working in Hospitals through frontline roles, directly supporting patients through the provision of food and linen services, and the supply of disability services and equipment through EnableNSW, as well as Information Communication Technology (ICT) innovation and support.
